#### CONFIRMATION

The Division of Animal Health will issue a Certificate that will include your pullorum tester number (i.e. – PT-136) once we have received:

- 1. Pullorum Typhoid Testing Application
- 2. Certification fee of \$30
- 3. Confirmation of testing certification course completion

Annual fee for the Pullorum Typhoid Tester certification is \$30 and yearly certification expires on September 30<sup>th</sup>. Testing supplies needs to be obtained through commercial sources.
